Literacy

Math

- Counted how many people live in our house
- Counted the days of the week

- Counted and sorted cubes
- Counted how many matches we made when we played the memory game

Science

- Determined the weather daily by looking outside and then finding the corresponding sign to post in our room
- Talked about the different seasons
- Talked about our plants and watered our plants
- Talked about how we grow

Gross Motor

- Played on the playground on the slides, rock wall, bicycles, and steps
- Stretched and danced to different songs in our room
- Danced to the Little Fish song in our classroom
- Danced with Miss Beth during music with the floor drum, and tom tom drums
- Visited the forklift outside in the parking lot that was here for our new playground structure

Fine Motor

- Used the mouse and computer keys during center time
- Putting some finishing touches on our all about me book
- Played with blocks in the block center
- Played the rubber duck game
- Played at the lego wall
- Used the magnet board with letters
- Practiced writing our names and drawing shapes
- Used instruments while we danced with Miss Beth
- Worked on a group puzzle together
- Played the matching game
