

The Ladybugs/Ha Mushiot
Week of January 23rd - January 27th , 2012

Literacy

- Talked about Bar/Bat Mitzvah's
- Talked about weddings, chuppah's, and a ketabuh
- Sang our morning song
- Read a book about rainbows.
- Found our names on the Ani Po/Lo Po chart, spelled our names and sounded out the first letters of our names and our friends names
- Continued to reinforce the following Hebrew words: Adom (red), Yarok (green) Tsahov (Yellow), Kahol (Blue), and Katom (Orange). Started to learn other Hebrew colors including Varod (Pink), and Shaxor (Black.) Also introduced the word Ketabuh, Chuppah, Bar and Bat Mitzvah, and Mazel Tov.
- Reinforced the rules of the classroom and the rules of our circle.
- Took turns spelling out our first name with letters that were placed on the floor in a pile and each child had to find their own letters to spell out their name.

Math

- Counted how many boys and girls are in our classroom and then completed a math problem totaling the number of children all together
- Counted how many children are allowed in each center
- Recognized shapes during calendar and learned that our shapes are in a pattern
- Counted to 10 in Hebrew and English before snack
- Picked out from a group of numbers what the appropriate number for the date is
- Counted the days of the week
- Counted out the napkins and the cups to give out to our friends for snack time
- Counted all of our 13 items our friends brought in to share to represent the age of a Bar/Bat Mitzvah
- Counted out 13 of any items we wanted to decorated our bulletin board inside our classroom

Science

- Determined the weather daily by looking outside and then finding the corresponding sign to post in our room
- Watered our classroom plants
- Checked on the status of our lima bean seeds...there is some progress!
- Talked about the upcoming planting we will be doing (we will be planting yellow squash)

- Used the magnifying glasses to look at our lima bean seeds

Gross Motor

- Played on the playground which includes the bicycles, slides, sand tables, rock climbing structure and airboat.
- Played “monster” with our friends outside which is a chasing game the kids made up
- Participated in music with Miss Beth. The children used an elastic band to stretch and pull while they sang different songs.
- Stretched and reached for the sky in our room, and did lots of other exercises! Did “Head, Shoulders, Knees, and Toes”, the Tooty Tot, and “The Fish Song.”

Fine Motor

- Used the mouse and computer keys during center time
- Built with and played with the gears
- Built structures with blocks in the block center this week the class built lots of bridges!
- Choose what types of materials we would like to use to make rainbows in honor of baby Rainbow.
- Our friends choose pom poms, confetti pieces, rubber pieces and made beautiful rainbows!
- Completed several large floor puzzles
- Practiced writing our names
- Used instruments and scarves while dancing in our classroom
- Used the sewing cards and laced different letters

Social/Self Help

- Continued our morning routine which includes unpacking backpacks, putting snacks in the bins, and putting lunch boxes into cubbies and putting backpacks away.
- Continued our afternoon routine of packing up our lunch boxes, putting them into our backpacks, putting our folder in our backpacks and zipping up our backpacks.
- Washed our hands when we walk in the room, before snack, after playground, before lunch and whenever necessary
- We talked about respecting each other’s personal space and not putting our hands on our friends. Reinforced the importance of using our words with our friends and that our hands are for handshakes and hugs not hurting one another.
