We hope everyone had an easy fast!! This week we started to discuss Sukkot. We discussed what a harvest was, where fruits and vegetables come from, and what a Sukkah was.

Literacy

- Read books about Sukkot
- Reminded our class of our classroom rules
- Sang our morning song
- Learned that Sukkot is the harvest and that we are thankful for the fruits and vegetables
- Discussed how to build a Sukkah and what a Sukkah looks like
- Found our names on the Ani Po/Lo Po chart
- Read "Happy 'Birthday to the World"
- Determined the day of week and found the correct corresponding sign to hang in our classroom
- Found our names during morning circle
- Learned the following Hebrew words: Sukkah, Yarok, and Tzahov

- Learned about the etrog and lulav with Mr. Elliot in the Sukkah

Math

- Counted how many boys and girls are in our classroom
- Counted how many children are allowed in each center
- Counted to the date during calendar
- Recognized shapes during calendar and learned that our shapes are in a pattern
- Counted to 10 in Hebrew and English before snack
- Counted how many different kind of fruits our friends brought into class for our fruit salad
- Counted the days of the week
- Counted how many seasons there are

Science

- Determined the weather daily by looking outside and then finding the corresponding sign to post in our room
- Talked about the different seasons
- Talked about the sun, moon, and stars that we see through the roof of the Sukkah
- Talked about the harvest and where our fruits and vegetables come from
- Mixed our fruit salad together

Gross Motor

- Danced to Sukkot songs on the carpet
- Played in the Sukkah with our friends
- Danced with Miss Beth during music

Fine Motor

- Used the mouse and computer keys during center time
- Used popsicle sticks to make a Sukkah on paper
- Sponge painted different fruits on our Sukkah
- Played with blocks in the block center
- Played the rubber duck game
- Played at the lego wall
- Used the magnet board with letters
- Marble painted different fruits and vegetables to decorate our Sukkah
- Used instruments while we danced with Miss Beth
- Mixed our fruit salad together

Social/Self Help

- Continued to learn our morning routine which includes unpacking backpacks, putting snacks in the bins, and putting lunch boxes into cubbies and putting backpacks away.
- Continued to learn our afternoon routine of packing up our lunch boxes, putting them into our backpacks, putting our folder in our backpacks and zipping up our backpacks.
